


Volume I *Christianity vs. Black Zionist Christianity*

The voice of the prophet within us is surer than them all and dares to insist. It's a new take on the subject because it is not only the likely groups exploring the idea, but now also mainstream Christians exploring this subject of Blacks in the Bible, something apparently prophesied to take place increasingly in these "last days."




